



Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997

Diversion of Bridleway (Section of Patna Bridleway at Carnshalloch Avenue, Patna) Order 2019

East Ayrshire Council hereby give notice that they have made an order under Section 208 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, authorising the permanent diversion of a section of the Patna Bridleway at:

CARNSHALLOCH AVENUE, PATNA

The section of bridleway will be permanently diverted to allow for the development of 19 dwellings, as a result of planning application 18/0409/PP. Copies of the Order and relevant plan specifying the section of the bridleway to be diverted and the diversion, may be inspected at the offices of Planning and Economic Development, the Johnnie Walker Bond, 15 Strand Street, Kilmarnock KA1 1HU, by any person free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period of 28 days from 22 March 2018. Within that period, any person may, by written notice to East Ayrshire Council, object to the making of the Order. Objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matters to which the objections relate and the grounds on which they are made.
